

Dual Boot Lion and Windows 7 on Lenovo G770

Requirements:

- Lenovo G770 laptop (i bought without OS)
- Windows 7
- working Snow Leopard
- Unibeast Lion + [Nawcom's MBR patch](#) on 8 GB USB stick (Installed Snow Leopard to able to create this as you do)
- GParted Live CD

Step 1.

Partition internal Hard Drive with GParted Live:

- with MBR partition table
- 3 partitions (at least):
 - o 8 GB HSF+ partition with boot flag for Unibeast Lion
 - o one HSF+ partition for Lion
 - o one NTFS partition for Windows 7

Step 2.

- install Windows 7 to NTFS partition

Step 3.

- install Unibeast Lion from a working Snow Leopard to internal 8 GB partition, this will boot the Lion and Win7
- patch Unibeast Lion with Nawcom's MBR patch

Step 4.

- restart and boot from internal HD
- choose internal 8 GB Unibeast Lion partition in boot menu to install Lion (This was my plan but I got display problem so I had to use Unibeast Lion USB stick)

Step 5.

- restart and boot from Unibeast 8 GB USB stick (MBR patched)
- install Lion to internal Lion partition
- restart and boot from Unibeast 8 GB USB stick to finish Lion install
- I use [your video tutorial](#) from 13th minute to install Lenovo kexts, dsdt, etc
- restart and boot from internal hard drive
- **Dual Boot Lion and Windows 7 on my Lenovo G770 is working finally!**
